## ORDER GRANTING CONSENT MOTION TO EXTEND THE OBJECTION DEADLINE AND CONTINUE THE HEARING ON THE TRUSTEE'S MOTIONS FOR RULE 2004 EXAMINATIONS

- 3. The Objection Deadline is extended, as it relates only to the Requesting Parties, up to and including **January 6, 2015**.
