- c. Second Interim Application for Compensation and Reimbursement of Expenses for Development Specialists, Inc., as Financial Advisor for the Trustee, Robert J. Keach, for the Period from May 1, 2014 Through September 30, 2014 [Docket No. 1168]; and
- d. Second Interim Application for Compensation and Reimbursement of Expenses for Verrill Dana LLP as Special Counsel to the Trustee for the Period of May 1, 2014 Through September 30, 2014 [Docket No. 1171];

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(collectively, the "<u>Applications</u>"), and upon consideration of all responses to the Motion to Expedite (if any), it is hereby <u>ORDERED</u>, <u>ADJUDGED</u> and <u>DECREED</u> as follows:

- 1. The Motion to Expedite is granted.
