Currie on the Basis that Such Claim is Unenforceable Against the* Debtor (the "<u>Objection</u>")<sup>1</sup> filed by Robert J. Currie* [D.E. 1281] (the "<u>Admin</u> Claim Application"), which supersedes the Claim.

2. Nothing in this Order shall prejudice any of the Trustee's or Mr. Currie's rights with respect to the Admin Claim Application, which rights are hereby preserved in their entireties.
